## Touchmark at Coffee Creek

A retirement community, Touchmark at Coffee Creek is part of Touchmark—a company that has been serving the needs of older adults and their families for 30 years.

The 25-acre Touchmark at Coffee Creek community is located in the 638-acre Coffee Creek planned residential development and golf course. It is adjacent to The Village Center at Coffee Creek, which includes dental, medical, and retail offices. Residents report the lifestyle is, “like a cruise ship on land with service at your fingertips.”

In 2010, Touchmark completed construction of a \$15 million expansion that includes a three-story addition and a one-level memory-care neighborhood, adding 73,000 square feet to the community.
